## Ischenko M.M. On methodological approaches to the regional management of heterogeneous social-and-economic systems

For modern regional social and economic systems the combination of the homogeneous and non-uniform elements which interaction is carried out on the basis of social and economic processes is typical. Thus known management methods aren't always effective for the social and economic systems possessing property of heterogeneity, in the absence of mechanisms of the coordination of operating decisions of the regional authorities directed on achievement of strategic targets of social and economic development and on decrease (overcoming) of heterogeneity of structural elements of systems. In given article the methodological approach to management of changes for the regional government system is offered, based on generalization of known theories of changes (the theory of recurrence, the theory of an environment and the conflict theory) and distribution of the best decisions and introduction of the institutes which have developed in the course of administrative reforming of regional government allows to provide.
