## Tagi-zade A.D. Law principle in the context of development and functioning of the law government: philosophic and law aspects

It is considered the law as a special control mechanism in the rule of law. Under the rule of law it is proposed to understand the mode (state) public relations compliance laws and regulations, which are not contrary to law, published in the public interest and should be made by all participants of legal relations. It is grounded the idea that legitimacy can not be based only on the physical or psychological compulsion, its origin is the interests and needs of people. The relations between legality and rights of the subject are positioned so that the legitimacy of a regime creates legal conditions for ensuring subjective rights, and the latter is a prerequisite for the existence of the rule of law as a specific social phenomenon. It is concluded that the legality of the full can exist only in democratic political regimes that ensure the adoption of laws that are appropriate to the nature of law
