## Biryukov A.V. Norm and law preventions of modern struggle with corruption in Russia

The conditions that determine the ability to achieve significant success in the fight against corruption are considered. The implementation process is a sequential solution of three interrelated problems. Firstly, it is determined the effect of the relative differences of the formal representatives of the public interest in government and on this basis to the exercise of personal goals under the guise of state and socially significant. Secondly, it is identified the cause of a sample implementation of their duties, turns red tape and corruption. Thirdly, it is determined the means for overcoming the actual corruption. This is the most promising way to achieve apparent success in today's environment where civil society in Russia is clearly not ready to speak out against corruption traditions, and representatives of political power do not dare to show integrity in the practice of anti-corruption movement. The problem should be addressed by means of legal education and the practice of regulation.
