Intuitivism concept analysis in A.Bergson, N.O. Lossky, D.B. Boldyrev's philosophy

In the creation of the postmodern model of the world intuitionist philosophy played an important role. It tried to reflect systematically the impending crisis of rationalism at the end of XIX – early XX century. Joining the debate with positivism, intuitionists proposed a new model of attitude. It analyzes the philosophy of the founders of European and national version of the intuitional, who were the first to expose the cult of consistent criticism of rationality, but could not avoid (especially in the European version) different extremes – absolute intuitive method of cognition.
