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General characteristics of implication as a condition of indirect character of the speech act

The article is devoted to the research of the peculiarities of the usage of indirect speech acts in the official sphere. It is taken into account two closely connected aspects of object and problem space. It is, firstly, categorial prerequisites of representation in the official sphere of an implication, as sign of the indirect speech act, and, secondly, its multidimensional characteristics. The analysis of the actual material allows to draw a conclusion, that using definite language means supposes two conditions: on the one hand, not to break the general systemacity, on the other, non-standardly represent the significant system relations, to actualize illocutive intentions. So, lack of specially expressed indicator of motivation can be defined as its indirect representation.
