The interaction of modern Russian law-making and law enforcement

Legislation is one of the main functions of the state, no less important is the enforcement function. The results of their interaction has been underestimated. The article discusses two unfavorable trends: the functioning of lawmaking in isolation from law enforcement, the development of law-making on quantitative rather than a qualitative way. Some amendments in legislation are revealed and presupposed by judicial practice, but in most cases numerous amendments make favorable conditions for fraud. Thus the prerogative task of law-making is to exclude any possibility of realization of fraud schemes.
