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Speech “diseases” as a consequence of the violation of a norm

It is considered the so-called speech "diseases" that occur in the Russian language and speech in connection with the violation of the norms at all levels. Medical approach to the terminal names is applied because many of the categorical nominations are formed by analogy with the terms of medicine, borrowed from biology, etc. To these “illnesses” can be referred, for example, kantselyarit, bitobit, naukovit, tzerkovit, politit and others. Trying to form this list of “diseases”, it can be said that all "diseases" of the Russian language constitute a kind of organized microterminal system within which they implement their values. Forming similar lists of "ailments", we can say that all "diseases" of the Russian language form a certain organized microtermsystem within which their values are realized. The core of this microtermsystem is not only a word-formation rate (all terms are formed by productive derivational models relevant for the medical sector), but also the internal motivation of terminological nomination, which is sufficiently transparent and clearly linked to determining some specific lexical formation
