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Denotative aspects of derived verbs semantics

It is considered questions about the nature of denotative approach in studying the semantics of the verb, which is examined as a multi-layered and diverse, nominating a particular situation as a whole. The verbs, representing a condensed expression, are not only nominating the process, but also calling the whole situation with its participants, their roles and intentions. The main advantage of the new model – content model can be performed by single rooted and different rooted synonyms, as they "may have identical denotative value relation to the same subject, the phenomenon of real or imagined reality.
