Philosophic and methodological analysis of the anthropic principle concept

It has been considered weak and strong anthropic principles in the context of the essence of the post-nonclassics. It is shown that the anthropic principle reflects the relationship between the Universum and the subject by observing, exploring and explaining it. The author substantiates the position that the concept of co-evolution shows the connection of man with the cosmos from the standpoint of Universal Evolutionism, understood as the evolution of all systems of the world within the boundaries of the Universum.
