Colloquial Russian in neologic description

It is considered the reflection of colloquial speech in the dictionaries of new words and the way of reflection of novelty of words in the vocabulary of colloquial speech. The main subjects of the study are “Dictionary of Russian colloquial speech” ed. L.P. Krysin and the latest dictionaries of the language of Internet. The author puts forth an issue of the linguistic status of the colloquial neologisms of Internet communication.
