Ideologically marked speech clichés in the soviet Constitutions

It is considered the ideologically marked speech clichés in the Constitutions of the Soviet period. Changes in the political system and in the ideological values in the country are reflected on different ideologically marked speech clichés. In the texts of the soviet Constitutions the following national mythologemes were identified: the mythologeme “we”–“the others” (enemies), the mythologeme “the national hero”, the mythologeme “national values”. The main national values of the soviet period were “solidarity”, “freedom”, “equal rights” and “labour”.
