Person's reflection in phraseological world picture of the Tatar language

In many phraseological terms a person becomes an object of evaluation. The article is devoted to the analysis of some phraseological units with an estimated human component (on the material of the Tatar language). In order to study the phraseological units of the Tatar language, the descriptive method and the method of continuous sampling are used to collect and systematize the materials; lexico-semantic method is introduced in the system analysis of factual material; methods of linguocultural, component and semantic analysis were used to highlight the cognitive features of the functioning of linguistic units; comparative methods were used in the translation of phraseological units. As a result of the semantic analysis of the units being researched, a description of the person from the set of positive, negative and neutral features is formed.
