### **Word-forming synonyms as a factor of stylistic changes in word formation**

Formations from the same base with different affixes, produced by the same or different methods of word-formation, actually and potentially present in the language, are common with synonyms of word-formation types. It is the presence of such entities that activates the interaction of synonymic types, stimulates their stylistic and semantic delimitation, the delimitation of spheres and conditions of their use, thus being an important factor in the development of the word-building system. Among the phenomena of word-formation by synonymy, we also consider types that differ in the grammatical nature of the production bases and are usually taken out of the limit of word-formation synonyms. Such an understanding of word-formation synonymy, which is broader in comparison with the traditional one, is explained by the results of its influence on the word-formation system.
