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Muslim way of life in the conceptual space of religion

In the conceptual space of religion, Islam is considered not just as a religious system, but as a peculiar way of life, in which there is no distinction between religious and secular spheres. Along with similar features between the major Abrahamic religions themselves, the specificity of the Shariah system for the regulation of Muslim acts in the religious system of Islam is presented, and the approaches to the essence of understanding religion in Islam and Christianity are different.
