## Gender-correct wording in argumentation texts (on the example of medical texts in modern German)

It is considered gender as one of the important directions of modern linguistics. It explores the possibilities of gender-correct language in argumentation medical texts on the material of the modern German language. Three groups of texts are identified in this specified group, the particularities of each of the subgroups are analyzed, as well as language means are systematized. Their use contributes to the gender correctness in these texts. In addition, options for the gender-correct wording as well as possibilities and use of synonymous expressions are considered. The particular attention is paid to the legal side of the text, namely, to the opportunity to use periphrases in references and quotes on legislative acts, as well as cases of mandatory conservation of designations used in them.
