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Ways to overcome phonetic interference in Russian speech of bilinguals (based on the Chechen language)

The article deals with the problem of overcoming errors that result from negative phonetic interference in the Russian speech of bilinguals (based on the material of the Chechen language). Typical errors typical of the Russian speech of bilingual Chechens are given, and some ways of overcoming these deviations from the norm are suggested. The necessary conditions for weakening and overcoming the interfering influence of the native language on non-native speech are considered. The conclusion states that it is possible to overcome interferential deviations in the Russian speech of bilinguals at the level of phonetics.
