Features and risks of the social technologies implementation of Modernity

The role of technology in the development of capitalist society is examined. Particular attention is paid to social technologies and the processes of technologicalization of social practices. The development of technology contributes to the emergence of new channels of communication between subjects and the genesis of new social institutions as forms of interaction between subjects of society in the fields of various social practices. When analyzing the society of early capitalism, the author explores Modern as a project for the reconstruction of society, within the framework of which certain social technologies are implemented. Modernity as a project in socio-economic and political aspects was focused not only on the capitalization of relations in European society and on its industrial and technological breakthrough, but also on the external expansion of the system, which took the form of colonization. Colonization ultimately led in the XX century to the depletion of human resources of the metropolis, and nowadays – to the growth of migration from the former colonies, as well as to the risk of extremist sentiments and terrorist activities among migrants, most often at the lower stages of the stratification systems of western societies.
