## Cognitive research in linguistics: interdisciplinary aspects

Cognitive studies in definite linguistic branches are consequently considered in the article. Their unity has sponsored the development of cognitive linguistics. Firstly, the parts of speech cognitive theory, as the representation of categorical nomination of reality, has been worked out. In the cognitive theory of wordbuilding a derivative word has acquired a categorical meaning and has become a generative medium for creating new denotation and new nomination of real objects. Valuable cognitive studies have taken place in the theory of motivation where motive quality – item is found out on the basis of image as the consciousness category. The theory of cognitive nomination is based on the statement of frame and prototype semantics, the theory of rhema identification "rhema-thema".
