## Communicative aspect in the study of thematically motivated vocabulary

The purpose of the study is to analyze the communicative groups of authors (KGA) writing about figure skating, the types of thematically motivated vocabulary (TMV) of this sport, as well as the relationship between the communicative groups of authors and the corresponding categories of thematically motivated vocabulary used by them. The scientific novelty of the work consists in conducting a communicative analysis of the TMV of this sport. As a result, it is shown which communicative group of authors prefers to use which terminated (non-deterministic) thematically motivated figure skating vocabulary, and which lexical units of the sport in question tends to avoid.
