Motives of conflict: pedagogical aspect of the study

It is justified that conflict prevention is both an ethical challenge and a pedagogically managed activity. Conflicts, as a rule, often arise on the basis of a collision of two equivalent motives. It happens that the requirements of the teacher are not fulfilled by the student due to the fact that he or she is motivated by joint interaction, or he or she is restrained by the previously made promise to someone.
