Features of reflection in the Erya dictionary and the explanatory dictionary of the living great Russian language by V.I. Dahl of the Chinese and Russian philosophical picture of the world

The philosophical picture of the world of the Chinese and Russian peoples, presented in the Erya dictionaries and the Explanatory Dictionary of the Living Great Russian language by V.I. Dahl, is the most stable component of the linguistic picture of the world, since it reflects the world viewed from the side of its most stable components – dead and living nature, psyche and culture. The reference to Erya dictionaries and the Explanatory Dictionary of V.I. Dahl allows us to get an idea of the intellectual activity of representatives of Chinese and Russian cognitive cultures. The dictionaries defining the movement of cultural semantics of ethnic groups, which include the Erya Dictionary and the Dictionary of the Living Great Russian Language by V.I. Dahl, present the hermeneutic experience of ethnic groups, the medium of which is language. Hermeneutical experience in dictionaries is fixed in special ways of word arrangement – thematic and "vatazhny" (words are selected by whole vatags under one common root).
