Communicative-linguistic ontology and digital being

It is considered the question of the correlation between communicative-linguistic ontology and digital being. Communicative-linguistic ontology is characterized by the subjectivity of the surrounding reality by the individual's consciousness; the real world objectivity; intersubjectivity as a single onto-epistemological space of discourse. A linguistic personality acts as an actor in digital ontology. Language, intersubjective communication, and the language community contribute to its formation as a phenomenon of modern life. Being in society, a linguistic personality assimilates socially constructed concepts, using the currently relevant conceptosphere as a basic onto-epistemological unit of digital ontology. The language community integrates the social and linguistic determinants of the conceptosphere and expresses them in discourse. A distinctive feature of digital being is *permanent communication* between subjects.
