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Semantic differentiation of reduplicates in the Adygean language

This article is devoted to the analysis of some aspects of the semantic differentiation of reduplicative formations of the substandard lexical subsystem of the Adyghe language. The relevance of this work is due to the lack of detailed studies in the field of reduplication, as a stylistically marked way of word formation, from the standpoint of the information content of lexical units and language economy, which determine the creation and functioning of reduplicates in speech. The purpose of the study is to consider some reduplicative units with somatic components. The research materials can be useful in lexicological practice when describing lexical units and the principles of their arrangement in dictionaries of various types.
