Constructed ethnoarchaic and archaeoavantgarde in the context of understanding the phenomenon of ethnocultural identity

The phenomenon of constructed ethnoarchaeics is being investigated, which is increasingly beginning to act as an element of inter-civilizational interaction, allegedly overcoming the identity crisis of modern ethno-cultural communities. It is noted that this phenomenon is followed by a minority uprising, which is no different in nature from the uprising of the masses.
