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This article is devoted to the philosophical reflection of the phenomenon of patriotism in Russian religious and philosophical thought in the second half of the XIX – early. XX centuries. The ideas of Russian religious thinkers are gaining particular relevance in modern conditions of confrontation with the new concept of conservative values in Russian ideology and the ideology of Western liberalism. An appeal to the origins of the reflections of Russian religious thinkers on the essence of patriotism leads to the doctrine of official nationality. However, an analysis of the interpretations of this phenomenon in the works of F.M. Dostoevsky, V.S. Solovyov, N.A. Berdyaev indicates that, recognizing patriotism as a high spiritual and moral value and personal feeling, to one degree or another revise the content of the main components of the triad of S.S. Uvarov and his associates.
